Criw Cymraeg will be helping us raise the profile of Welsh throughout the school as well as working on the Cymraeg Campus Silver award.












Our Focus group are a group of representatives from other groups to look at the curriculum and the School Priorities.

A big thank you also to the parents who attended - we hope you found the session helpful. We will be sharing the information with you soon.










