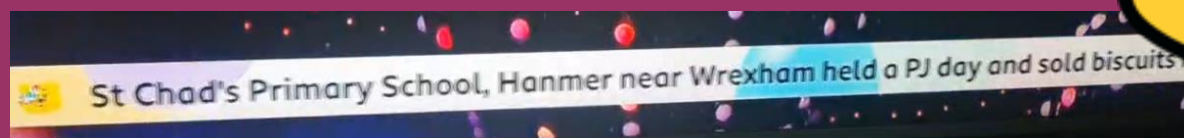
## Newsletter- Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November
