At St Chad's School we were all saddened to learn of the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. As our country's longest reigning monarch, Queen Elizabeth had been one of the most significant people in our history and her loss will be felt by many. At school we held special collective worships for all the children and staff to remember this truly exceptional person and to pay tribute to her devotion and dedication to her people. Our Religion, Values and Ethics lessons that week were a time to reflect on the Queen and her role as a Monarch.

The children created pictures and prayers for His Majesty the King and the Royal Family that were placed in the book of condolences in St Chad's Church. One child's prayer in Year 4 read, 'Dear God, Thank you for the 70 years reigning over us. May we pray for you and your child King Charles III. It has been a time of happiness and sadness. Thank you for your dedication, our gracious Queen. Amen'

Thinking and reflecting back to May this year we were blessed to be able to mark and celebrate the historic occasion of Her Majesty the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. Our topic during the summer of the Queen had really helped the children to gain a great understanding and awareness of the longevity of her reign, the role she played in the Commonwealth and her responsibilities.



Our community jubilee celebration that involved a re-enactment of the Queen's coronation in St Chad's Church followed by an afternoon tea on the school field with a crown parade and presentation of souvenir mugs marked this huge period in history. 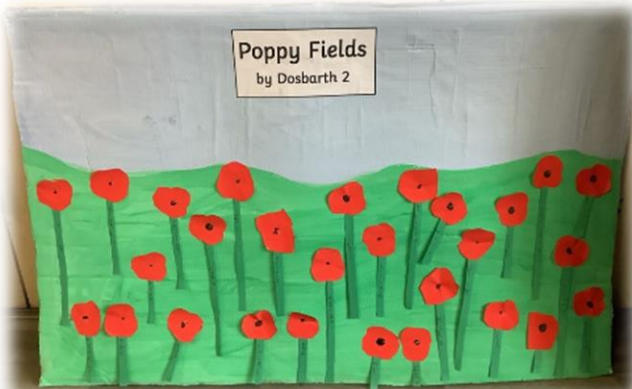
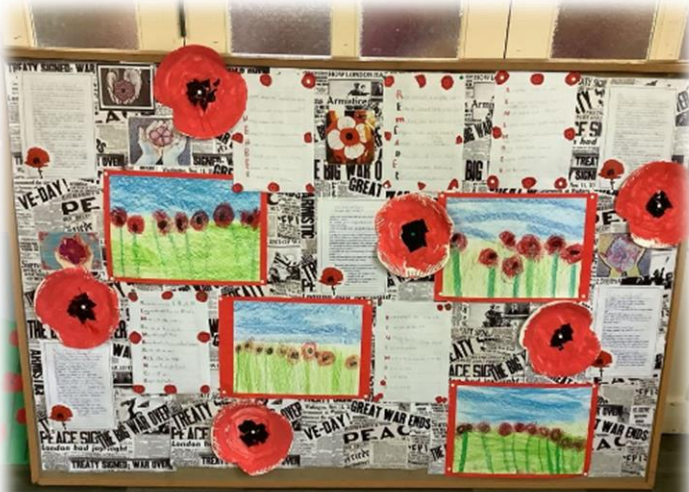
