





It was our last session of rugby this week. The children have throughully loved developing their rugby skills. There are still places available on the rugby camps. (FSM pupils can access this for free)

All classes have shown how they are healthy and confident learners by keeping safe and making measured decisions and managing risk. As well as eating s'mores!








St Chad's Book Week
