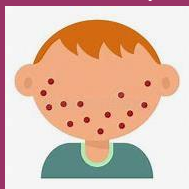

Arriving late means missing crucial early-morning learning activities like phonics, handwriting, and number work. This puts children at a significant disadvantage.

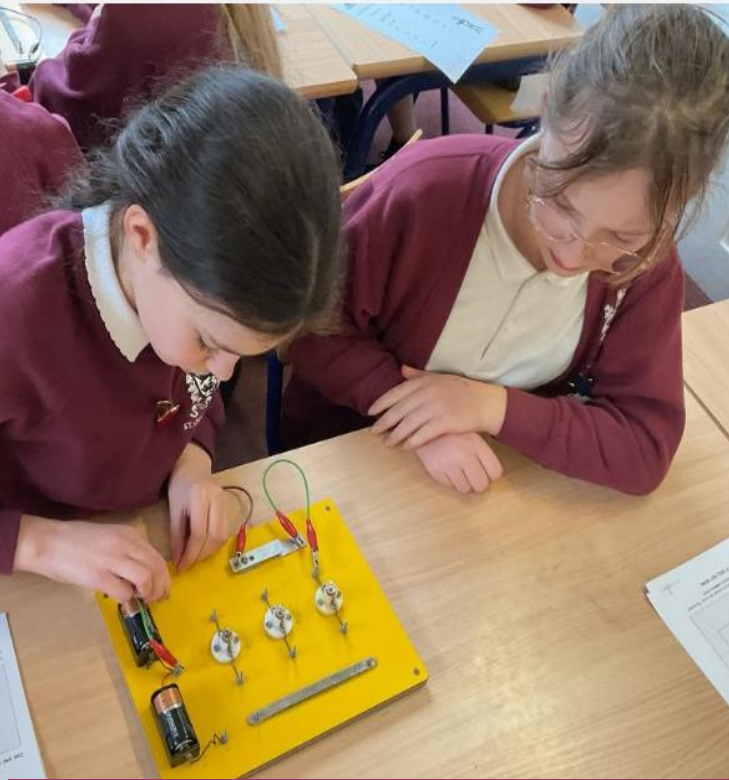
