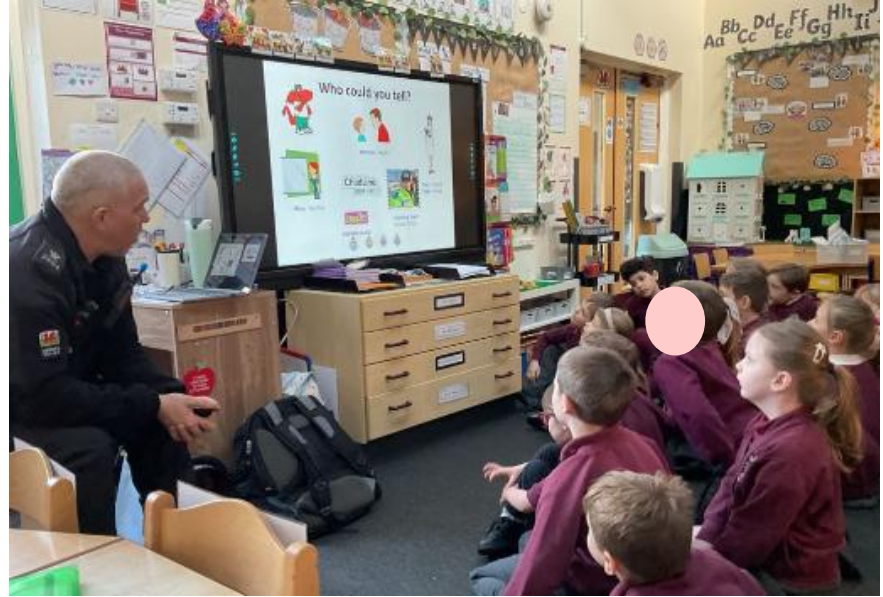

This week, we were delighted to welcome PC Mark into school to work with Dosbarth 2 and Dosbarth 3.

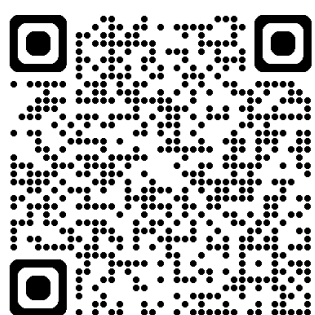
In Dosbarth 2, he talked with the children about how to stay safe at home, helping them understand what to do in different situations and how to make sensible choices.

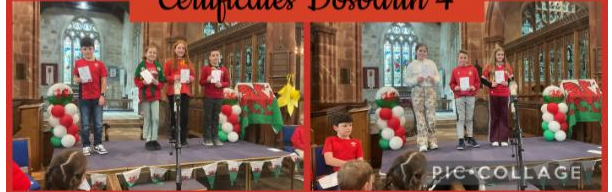
