

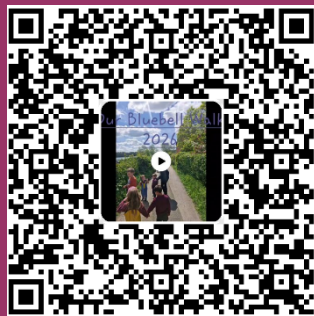
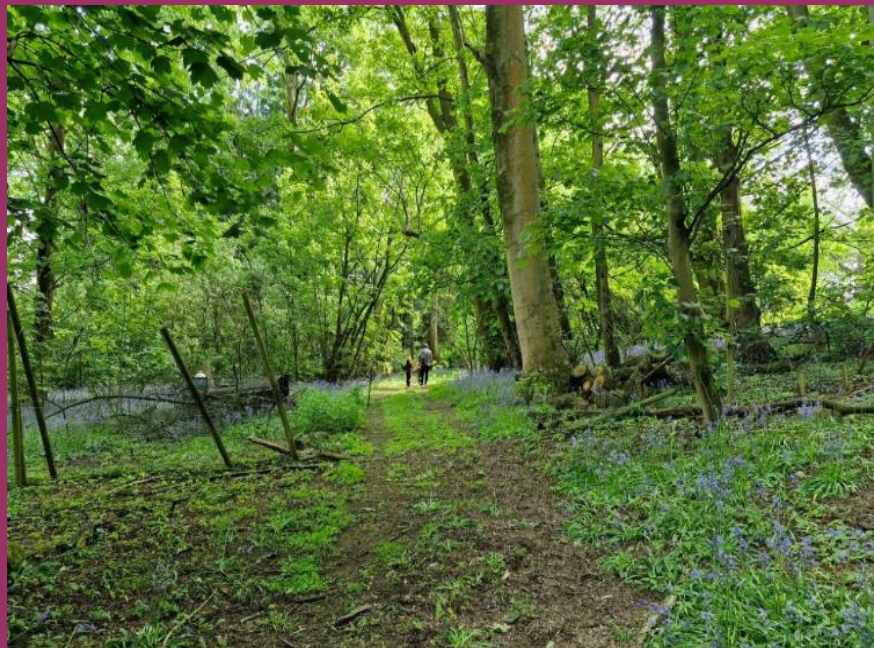


Newsletter Friday 8th May 2026

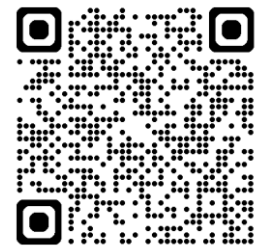

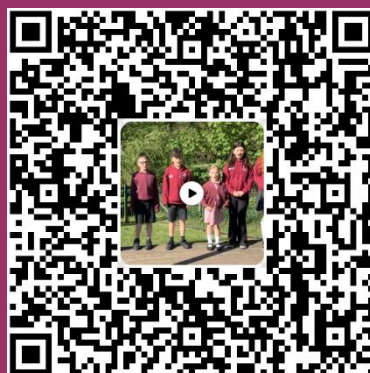

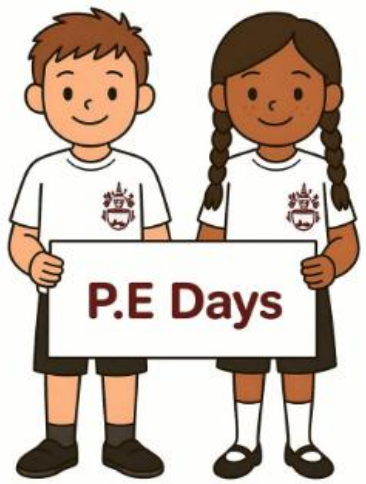
