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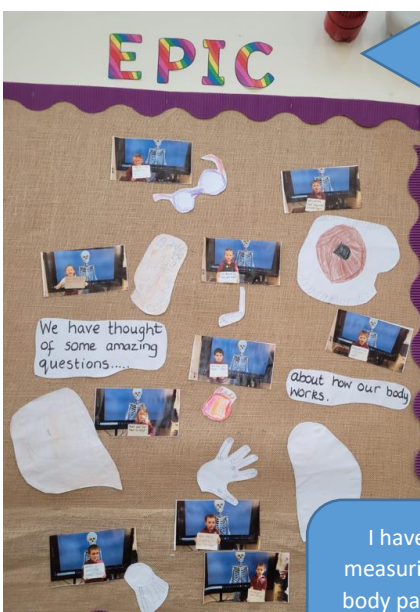

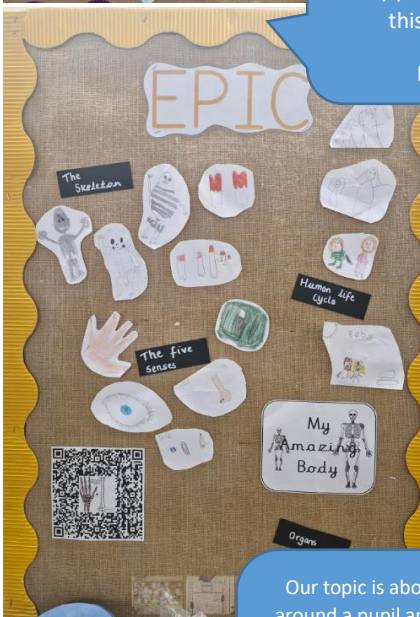

The classrooms have been buzzing this week, with lots of fantastic questions and enquiries to learn about!



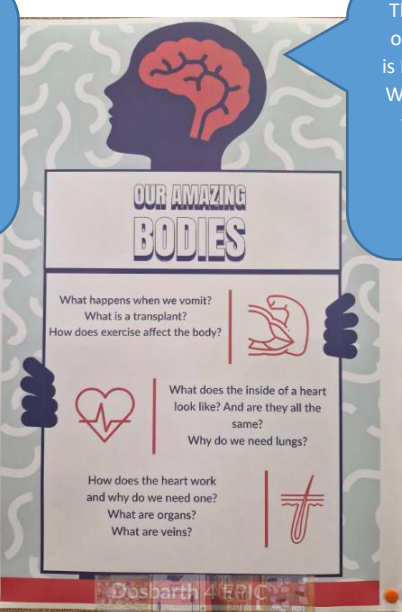
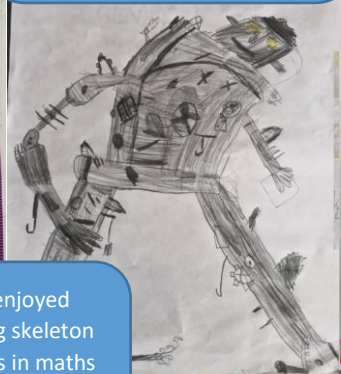
I am excited about learning about the skeleton! I want to find out if ears have bones!

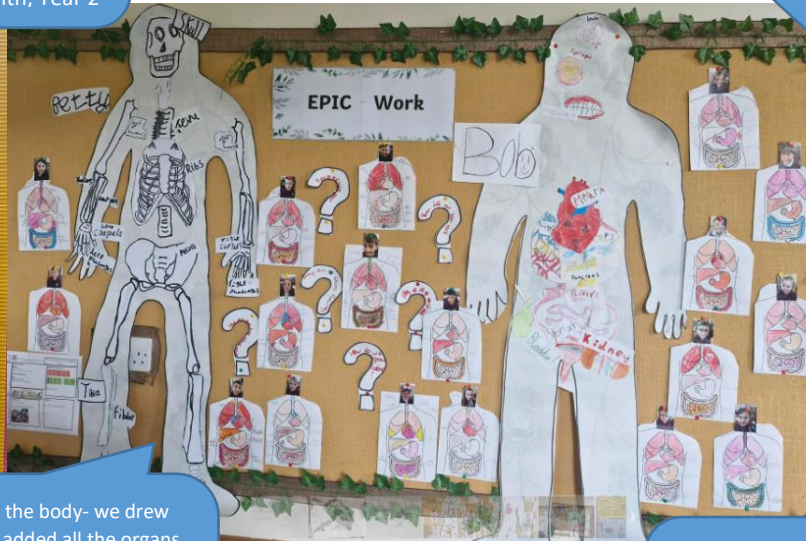
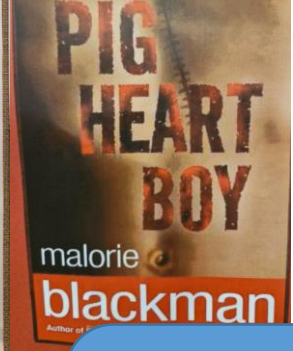
I have enjoyed measuring skeleton body parts in maths this week!

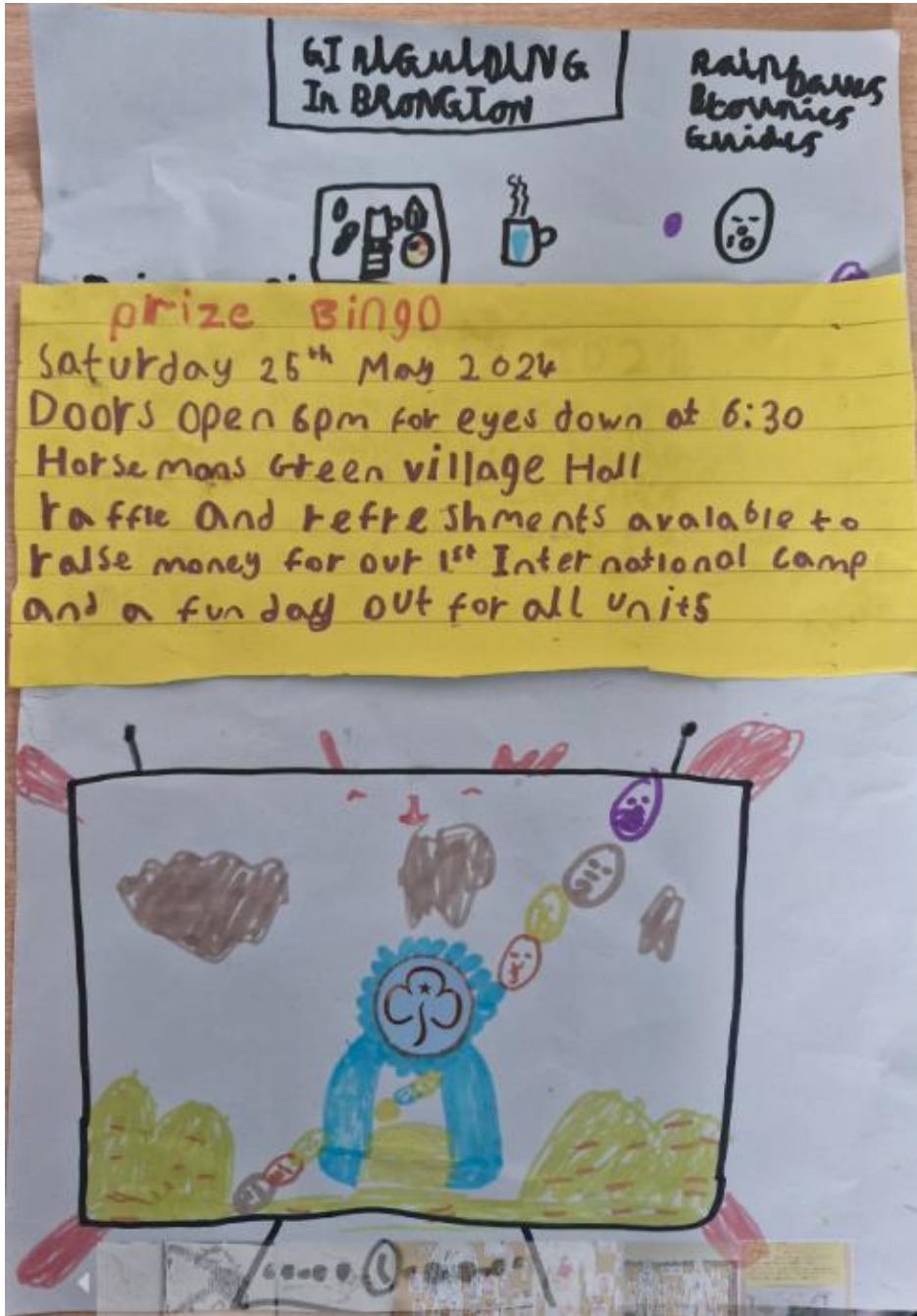

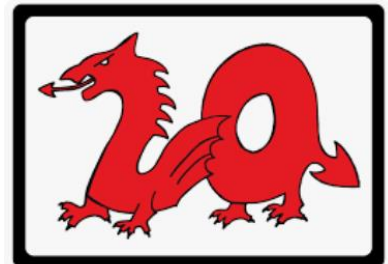
## Celebration Assembly

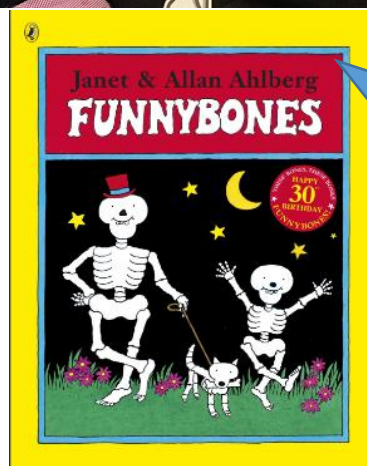
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Something very exciting happened in Dosbarth 2 this week!
