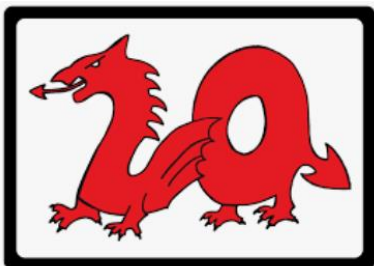
Criw Cymraeg
