Thank you for your support in ensuring a punctual start to the school day.

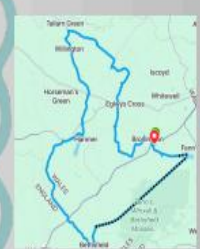

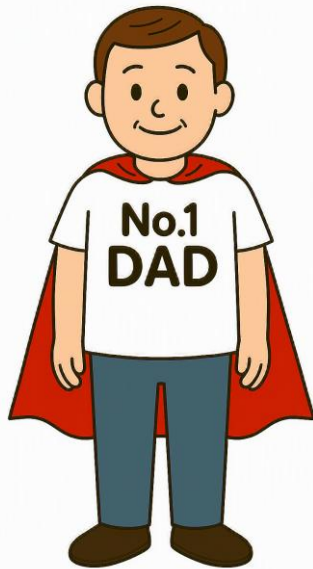

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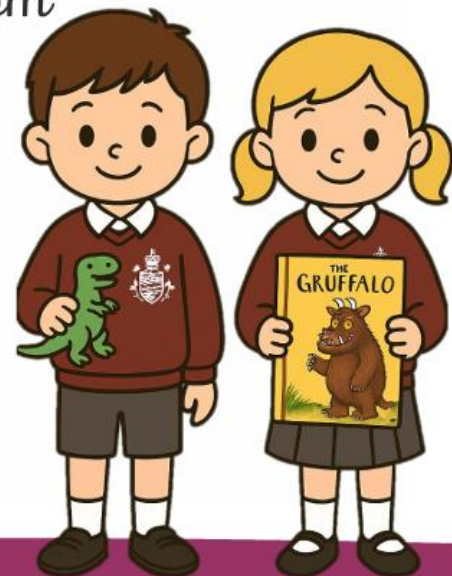
Nursery and Reception Parents' Welcome Evening
