If you are experiencing difficulties with punctuality, please do not hesitate to contact me to discuss potential solutions.

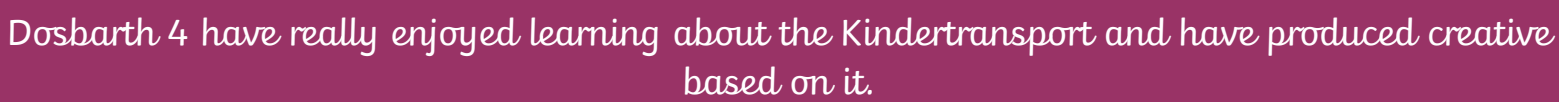
We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring your child arrives at school on time. Together, we can create a positive and productive learning environment for all.
